Old Business:

Kathy reported that the Spring Jamboree held at Milton had 72 dancers in attendance, and the two free passes that were given out went to Robin Alpenglow and Billie Weisensel. Six people registered for the convention, and the dance netted \$213 for the SDAW. Sheets were also passed out for Volunteers to assist with registration at the 2010 convention.

The State Sdaw meeting was held on May 2nd Lloyd Gatzke led a discussion about the lack of a chair person for the 2012 convention. He stated that if a chair is obtained, there will be a need for volunteers from other areas to assist with the 2012 event.

June Myklebust reported that she has new square dance flags available.

The taxes have been filed, and no taxes were due. The insurance has been paid for the year. Registrations for the 2010 convention at the present time are 210 dancers, 25 callers and 11 Quers

Scott Kittle has been appointed to take care of the new State SDAW website which will be up and running in the next few weeks. Delegates to the USDA Meeting held at the National Convention are June Myklebust and Bob Dahnert and Lloyd and Joyce Gatzke.

June Myklebust gave an update on the 2011 convention. She reported that the committee rehearsed the skit that will be performed at the 2010 convention. The skit is based on Robin Hood and we need audience participation from Southwest area dancers. A rehearsal is planned for Friday morning. Badges and Ribbons have been selected, and estimates for printing are being obtained. The DeForest Board approved Camping at the High School for the convention. Ads have been delivered to the printer for the convention program

The Fall Jamboree will be at DeForest on 10/10/10, Circus City and Diamond Squares will host the event.

A motion to adjourn was made at 8:00pm by June Myklebust, 2nd by Curt Shawkey Motion carried.
